Billing Chiropractic Claims Electronically

When billing chiropractic claims electronically, the claim must contain an initial treatment date.

Implementation Guide Specifics

- **Initial Treatment Date** - The Initial Treatment Date (ITD) is the date of the initial treatment (visit) or the date of exacerbation of the existing condition. It is not the first date that a chiropractor saw the patient in their office.
 - Example: DTP*454*D8*20040615~
 - The ITD is required on all claims involving spinal manipulation.
 - The ITD is submitted in Loop 2300 (Claim Information).
 - The ITD is reported in a DTP segment in the format CCYYMMDD.
 - The Date/Time Qualifier must be submitted as 454.
